

No-Cost Extension for Smart Policing

Grant #2009-DG-BX-0118

The Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) requests a six-month no-cost extension for the BJA grant, Smart Policing in the Los Angeles Police Department

Amount of additional time needed: The current end date for the project is December 31, 2013 and we request an extension until June 30, 2014.

Why the extension is necessary:

Operation LASER has been expanded to include six patrol divisions. In addition to Newton Division (the original location for Smart Policing), Captains at Foothill, Hollenbeck, Southwest, Topanga, and Wilshire have agreed to implement the model. This means crime analysts, officers, and detectives from these divisions will be trained over the next six months. With the completion of the training room at RACR Division with Smart Policing funds, staff will receive training on Palantir and the Omega Dashboard, both of which are essential to crime and intelligence analysis.

In addition, the Research Partner, Justice & Security Strategies, will collect and analyze data for these divisions for evaluation purposes.

What you intend to do in the extended time:

An extension will allow us to continue to train staff and evaluate the impact of Operation LASER in six patrol divisions.
