

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT
AND FLOCK CAMERAS

DATE: 8/19/19

I. Parties

This Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter “MOA” or “Agreement”) is entered into by and between The Los Angeles Police Department (“LAPD”) and Flock Group Inc. (hereinafter “Flock”).

II. Purpose

The purpose of the MOA is to codify the terms under which the LAPD will utilize Flock’s ALPR camera system, which is a closed multi array camera system which utilizes integrated License Plate Recognition Reader and Vehicle Imagery gathering and categorizing software to collect data imagery and transmit it to a Flock controlled restricted secure database via encrypted internet transmission.

Flock will provide equipment (approximately 50 cameras), training, support, software, data security, data storage, data analysis software, mounting equipment and contract labor at not cost to the LAPD for the six (6) month term of this Agreement.

III. Information Ownership

All content data and related statistics generated from their collection are owned wholly and solely by the LAPD and may not be accessed, deleted, modified, enhanced, altered or otherways manipulated in size, form, format or content without expressed written permission from an authorized LAPD Officer. Flock will ensure LAPD has access and dominion over its data at all times and without reservation even in event of agreement termination, dispute or suspension. ALPD will have access to both raw and tabulated data.

DATA SECURITY

Flock will ensure that the security, control, and usage of all data provided by the LAPD and/or collected utilizing using Flock devices for LAPD use is consistent with recognized, legitimate law enforcement data security practices and purposes and that any release of this data beyond the terms of this agreement is expressly forbidden.

IV. Hardware Ownership

All Flock supplied computer, cellular, battery, housing and mounting hardware, including operating and analysis software is the property of Flock and LAPD shall not take title or claim ownership or dominion over such items.

V. Mounting and Dismounting of Hardware

Flock will mount and dismount all hardware and secure the right to do so when placed on private property. When cameras are placed on public property, LAPD will secure for Flock the right to do so however, Flock will remain responsible for all mounting and dismounting.

VI. Use of Terms: "LAPD," its Logo, Slogan, Badge, Images of LAPD Officers or Equipment for the Purposes of Endorsement.

The LAPD maintains sole control over its name, trademark and logos for business purposes and does not allow such items to be used for marketing or promotional purposes without exception.

VII. Training

Flock will provide initial and on-going training and 24/7 access to user support during the term of this agreement.

IX. Terms of Use

This MOA shall be effective for six (6) months from the date the last party signs. Either The LAPD or Flock may terminate its participation in this MOA for any reason whatsoever at any time upon thirty (30) days advanced written notice to the other party. Both parties agree that performance of their responsibilities under this Agreement is contingent on available resources.

IX. General Provisions

- A. Each party assumes full responsibility for workers' compensation insurance, and payment of all Federal, State and local taxes or contributions, including but not limited to unemployment insurance, Medicare and income taxes with respect to its own employees. LAPD is not liable for Contractors hired by Flock for any aspect of implementing this Agreement.
- B. Both parties have no existing financial interest and will not acquire any such interest, direct or indirect, which could conflict in any manner or degree with

the performance of services required under this MOA, and no person having any such interest shall be subcontracted in connection with this MOA, or employed by either party.

- C. Both parties agree that this MOA is subject to all Federal, State and Local laws, applicable rules and regulations.

X. Liability

Flock assumes all liability for its equipment and its loss. LAPD explicitly does not take responsibility for Flock equipment or its loss due to specific acts of God, nature or criminal vandalism.

XI. Resolution of Conflicts

Should a conflict of interest arise, the parties agree to fully cooperate in any inquiry and to provide each other with all documents or other information reasonably necessary to investigate whether or not a conflict of interest existed or exists.

Neither party will provide a statement, public disclosure or comment on this Agreement or the status of its implementation without the expressed written approval of the other party.

XII. Termination of Agreement

This Agreement will expire six (6) months after the date of the last signature of either party. Either the LAPD or Flock may terminate its participation in this MOA for any reason whatsoever at any time upon thirty (30) days advanced written notice to the other party.

XIII. Changes to Agreement, Extensions, Early Termination

No changes or modifications to this MOA shall be effective unless such changes or modifications are in the form of a written amendment signed by both parties.

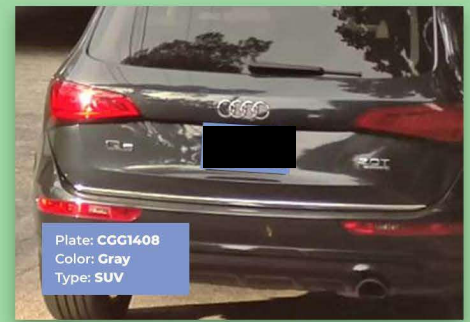

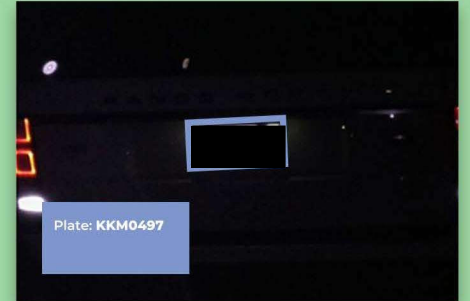

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Data Sharing Memorandum of Understanding (this “**MOU**”) is entered into by and between Flock Group, Inc. with a place of business at 2588 Winslow Drive, Atlanta, GA 30305 (“**Flock**”) and the police department or agency identified in the signature block below (“**Agency**”) (each a “**Party**”, and together, the “**Parties**”).

Whereas, Agency desires to access Flock’s technology platform (the “**Flock Service**”) in order to view and search videos recorded by Flock (“**Recordings**”) which are stored for no longer than 30 days, utilizing its software for automatic license plate detection;

Whereas, Flock desires to share such videos with Agency pursuant to the following terms and conditions.

1. **Purpose.** To allow the Agency to utilize the Flock Services for the following purpose: [to gain awareness with respect to the communities for which they serve to protect] (the “**Purpose**”).
2. **Access Rights to Flock Services.** Subject to the terms and conditions contained in this MOU, Flock hereby grants to Agency a non-exclusive, non-transferable right to access the features and functions of the Flock Service during the Term (as defined below), solely for use by Authorized Users in accordance with the terms and conditions herein. For purposes of this MOU, “Authorized Users” will mean employees, agents, or officers of Agency accessing or using the Flock Services for the Purpose. Agency acknowledges and agrees that, as between Agency and Flock, Agency shall be responsible for all acts and omissions of Authorized Users, and any act or omission by an Authorized User which, if undertaken by Agency, would constitute a breach of this MOU, shall be deemed a breach of this MOU by Agency. Agency shall undertake reasonable efforts to make all Authorized Users aware of the provisions of this MOU as applicable to such Authorized User’s use of the Flock Service, and shall cause Authorized Users to comply with such provisions.
3. **Restrictions on Use.** Agency will not, and will not permit any Authorized Users or any third party to, (i) copy or duplicate any of the Flock Service; (ii) decompile, disassemble, reverse engineer or otherwise attempt to obtain or perceive the source code from which any software component of any of the Flock Service is compiled or interpreted; (iii) modify, alter, or tamper with any of the Flock Service, or create any derivative product from any of the foregoing; (iv) interfere or attempt to interfere in any manner with the functionality or proper working of any of the Flock Service; (v) remove, obscure, or alter any notice of any intellectual property or proprietary right appearing on or contained within any of the Flock Service; or (vi) assign, sublicense, sell, resell, lease, rent or otherwise transfer or convey, or pledge as security or otherwise encumber, Agency’s rights under Sections 2.
4. **Ownership.** As between the Parties, subject to the rights granted in this MOU, Flock and its licensors retain all right, title and interest in and to the Flock Service, and its components and any Recordings or data provided by Flock through the Flock Service, and Agency acknowledges that it neither owns nor acquires any additional rights in and to the foregoing not expressly granted by this MOU. Agency further acknowledges that Flock retains the right to use the foregoing for any purpose in Flock’s sole discretion. There are no implied rights.
5. **Financial Implications to Agency.** No financial commitment by Agency is required to access the Flock Services or Recordings.
6. **Term; Termination.**

- A. **Term.** This MOU will commence once executed by both parties and shall continue for a period of [5] years.
 - B. **Termination.** Flock may terminate this MOU for its convenience, and in its sole discretion, by providing Agency thirty (30) days prior written notice of termination. Agency may terminate this MOU for its convenience, and in its sole discretion, by providing Agency ninety (90) days prior written notice of termination. Either party may terminate this MOU upon written notice if the other party has breached a material term of this MOU and has not cured such breach within thirty (30) days of receipt of notice from the non-breaching party specifying the breach. Upon termination of this MOU, Agency will immediately cease all use of Flock Services.
7. **Indemnification.** Each Party to this MOU shall assume the responsibility and liability for the acts and omissions of its own employees, deputies, officers, or agents, in connection with the performance of their official duties under this MOU. For tort liability purposes, no participating Party shall be considered the agent of the other participating Party. Each Party to this MOU shall be liable (if at all) only for the torts of its own officers, agents, or employees that occur within the scope of their official duties. Under no circumstances shall this MOU be interpreted to create a partnership or agency relationship between the Parties.
8. **Limitation of Liability.**

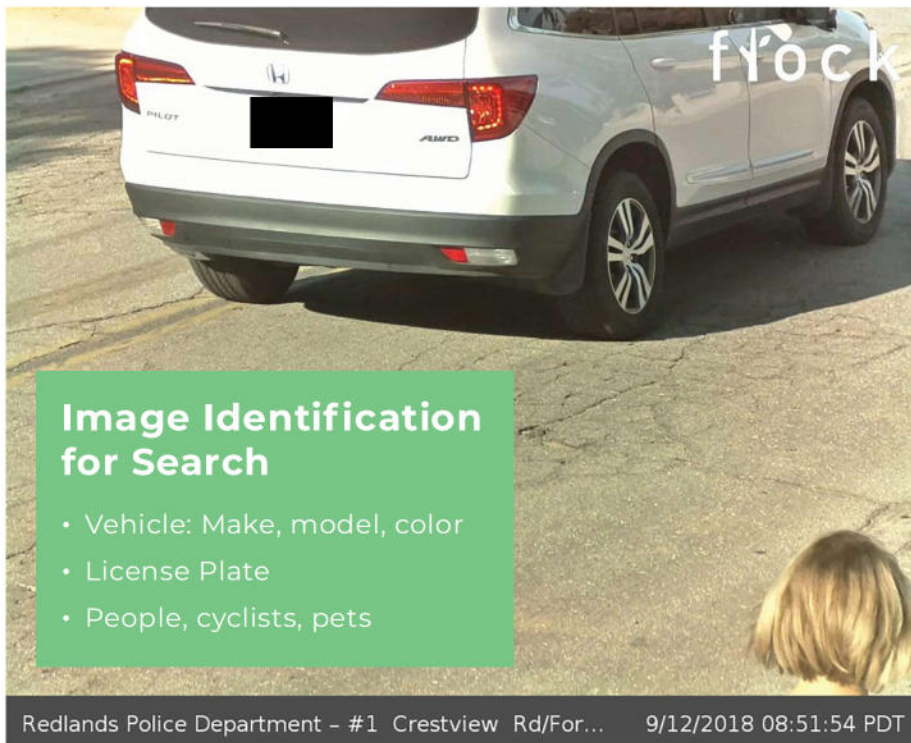

This Data Sharing Memorandum of Understanding (this “**MOU**”) is entered into by and between Flock Group, Inc. with a place of business at 2588 Winslow Drive, Atlanta, GA 30305 (“**Flock**”) and the police department or agency identified in the signature block below (“**Agency**”) (each a “**Party**”, and together, the “**Parties**”).

Whereas, Agency desires to access Flock’s technology platform (the “**Flock Service**”) in order to view and search videos recorded by Flock (“**Recordings**”) which are stored for no longer than 30 days, utilizing its software for automatic license plate detection;

Whereas, Flock desires to share such videos with Agency pursuant to the following terms and conditions.

1. **Purpose.** To allow the Agency to utilize the Flock Services for the following purpose: [to gain awareness with respect to the communities for which they serve to protect] (the “**Purpose**”).
2. **Access Rights to Flock Services.** Subject to the terms and conditions contained in this MOU, Flock hereby grants to Agency a non-exclusive, non-transferable right to access the features and functions of the Flock Service during the Term (as defined below), solely for use by Authorized Users in accordance with the terms and conditions herein. This MOU does not convey access to Agency in locations where access is restricted by contract between Flock and its Customer(s). It is the responsibility of both Flock and the Agency to ensure compliance with these restricted contracts. For purposes of this MOU, “Authorized Users” will mean employees, agents, or officers of Agency accessing or using the Flock Services for the Purpose. Agency acknowledges and agrees that, as between Agency and Flock, Agency shall be responsible for all acts and omissions of Authorized Users, and any act or omission by an Authorized User which, if undertaken by Agency, would constitute a breach of this MOU, shall be deemed a breach of this MOU by Agency. Agency shall undertake reasonable efforts to make all Authorized Users aware of the provisions of this MOU as applicable to such Authorized User’s use of the Flock Service, and shall cause Authorized Users to comply with such provisions.
3. **Restrictions on Use.** Agency will not, and will not permit any Authorized Users or any third party to, (i) copy or duplicate any of the Flock Service; (ii) decompile, disassemble, reverse engineer or otherwise attempt to obtain or perceive the source code from which any software component of any of the Flock Service is compiled or interpreted; (iii) modify, alter, or tamper with any of the Flock Service, or create any derivative product from any of the foregoing; (iv) interfere or attempt to interfere in any manner with the functionality or proper working of any of the Flock Service; (v) remove, obscure, or alter any notice of any intellectual property or proprietary right appearing on or contained within any of the Flock Service; or (vi) assign, sublicense, sell, resell, lease, rent or otherwise transfer or convey, or pledge as security or otherwise encumber, Agency’s rights under Sections 2.
4. **Ownership.** As between the Parties, subject to the rights granted in this MOU, Flock and its licensors retain all right, title and interest in and to the Flock Service, and its components. Agency further acknowledges that Flock retains the right to use the foregoing for any purpose in Flock’s sole discretion. There are no implied rights. Any Recordings or data provided by Flock through the Flock Service is solely owned by Flock’s customers as provided in their respective SaaS customer agreements, and Agency acknowledges that it neither owns nor acquires any additional rights in and to the foregoing not expressly granted by this MOU.
5. **Financial Implications to Agency.** No financial commitment by Agency is required to access the Flock Services or Recordings.
6. **Term; Termination.**

- A. **Term.** This MOU will commence once executed by both parties and shall continue for a period of [5] years.
 - B. **Termination.** Flock may terminate this MOU for its convenience, and in its sole discretion, by providing Agency thirty (30) days prior written notice of termination. Agency may terminate this MOU for its convenience, and in its sole discretion, by providing Agency ninety (90) days prior written notice of termination. Either party may terminate this MOU upon written notice if the other party has breached a material term of this MOU and has not cured such breach within thirty (30) days of receipt of notice from the non-breaching party specifying the breach. Upon termination of this MOU, Agency will immediately cease all use of Flock Services.
7. **Indemnification.** Each Party to this MOU shall assume the responsibility and liability for the acts and omissions of its own employees, deputies, officers, or agents, in connection with the performance of their official duties under this MOU. For tort liability purposes, no participating Party shall be considered the agent of the other participating Party. Each Party to this MOU shall be liable (if at all) only for the torts of its own officers, agents, or employees that occur within the scope of their official duties. Under no circumstances shall this MOU be interpreted to create a partnership or agency relationship between the Parties.
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- A. **Limitation on Direct Damages.** IN NO EVENT SHALL FLOCK'S AGGREGATE LIABILITY, IF ANY, ARISING OUT OF OR IN ANY WAY RELATED TO THIS MOU EXCEED \$100, WITHOUT REGARD TO WHETHER SUCH CLAIM IS BASED IN CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), PRODUCT LIABILITY OR OTHERWISE.
 - B. **Waiver of Consequential Damages.** IN NO EVENT SHALL FLOCK OR ITS LICENSORS OR SUPPLIERS BE LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, PUNITIVE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, LOSS OF DATA OR LOSS OF PROFITS, WITHOUT REGARD TO WHETHER SUCH CLAIM IS BASED IN CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), PRODUCT LIABILITY OR OTHERWISE, EVEN IF FLOCK HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.
9. **Confidentiality.**
- A. **Obligations.** Each of the parties agrees to maintain in confidence any non-public information of the other party, whether written or otherwise, disclosed by the other party in the course of performance of this MOU that a party knows or reasonably should know is considered confidential by the disclosing party ("Confidential Information"). The parties hereby agree that Confidential Information includes the terms and conditions of this MOU, and any discussions related thereto as well as the Flock Services. The receiving party shall not disclose, use, transmit, inform or make available to any entity, person or body any of the Confidential Information, except as a necessary part of performing its obligations hereunder, and shall take all such actions as are reasonably necessary and appropriate to preserve and protect the Confidential Information and the parties' respective rights therein, at all times exercising at least a reasonable level of care. Each party agrees to restrict access to the Confidential Information of the other party to those employees or agents who require access in order to perform hereunder, and, except as otherwise provided, neither party shall make Confidential Information available to any other person or entity without the prior written consent of the other party.

- B. **Exclusions.** Confidential Information shall not include any information that is (i) already known to the receiving party at the time of the disclosure; (ii) publicly known at the time of the disclosure or becomes publicly known through no wrongful act or failure of the receiving party; (iii) subsequently disclosed to the receiving party on a non-confidential basis by a third party not having a confidential relationship with the other party hereto that rightfully acquired such information; or (iv) communicated to a third party by the receiving party with the express written consent of the other party hereto. A disclosure of Confidential Information that is legally compelled to be disclosed pursuant to a subpoena, summons, order or other judicial or governmental process shall not be considered a breach of this MOU; provided the receiving party provides prompt notice of any such subpoena, order, or the like to the other party so that such party will have the opportunity to obtain a protective order or otherwise oppose the disclosure.

10. **Miscellaneous.** All notices, requests, demands, or other communications required or permitted to be given hereunder must be in writing and must be addressed to the parties at their respective addresses set forth below and shall be deemed to have been duly given when (a) delivered in person; (b) sent by facsimile transmission To the facsimile number below and indicating receipt at the facsimile number where sent; (c) one (1) business day after being deposited with a reputable overnight air courier service; or (d) three (3) business days after being deposited with the United States Postal Service, for delivery by certified or registered mail, postage pre-paid and return receipt requested. This MOU shall be governed by the laws of the state in which the Agency is located, excluding its conflict of laws rules. The parties agree that the United Nations Convention for the International Sale of Goods is excluded in its entirety from this MOU.
